Ashland increases prices on 1-4 butanediol and derivatives in the Americas

DUBLIN, OHIO, December 6, 2016 – Ashland is increasing prices in the Americas for 1-4 butanediol (BDO) and its derivatives. Prices will increase \$0.04 per pound (\$0.09 per kilogram) for BDO, tetrahydrofuran (THF), n-methyl-pyrrolidone (NMP) and BLO[®] butylrolactone solvent. The price for 2-pyrol will increase \$0.10 per pound (\$0.22 per kilogram). The changes are effective January 3, 2017, or as contracts allow.

The change reflects evolving market conditions and will allow Ashland to continue to provide its customers with the premium level services that they currently receive.
